



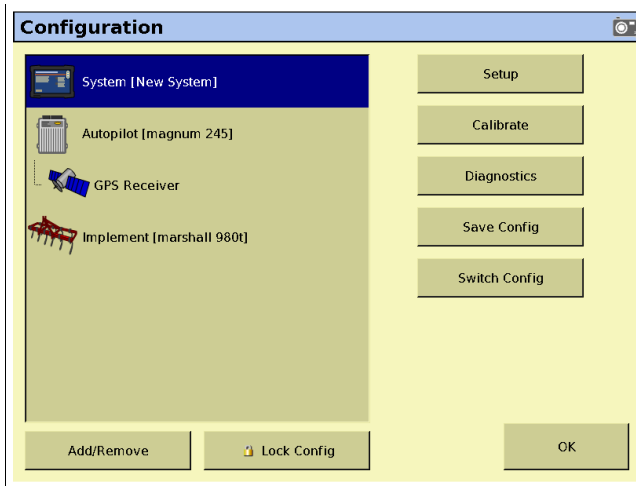


## Saving FM1000 Configuration.

The FM1000 saves individual configurations of the system components separately. Each of the items listed in the configuration page are saved individually.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Select '<b>Setting</b>' on the top Right of the Home Screen.</li> </ul> 
	<p>Each item in the list needs to be saved individually.</p> <p>When the item is indented (i.e. GPS Receiver) it's settings are saved with the higher level settings.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Highlight the item in Blue to select it.</li> <li>• Select '<b>Save Config</b>'.</li> </ul> <p><b>NOTE:</b> If this button is locked you will be prompted for the <u>Administration Password - 2009</u></p> <p>A screen will appear asking if you want to <b>overwrite</b> the existing configuration or <b>save</b> these settings as a <b>new configuration</b></p>
	<p>If you select <b>New</b> a keyboard will appear that allows you to type in a name for the configuration.</p> <p>The name should be something that will be remembered and is meaningful.</p> <p>i.e. for an EZ-Steer system that will be moved between vehicles, use the name of the vehicle.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• When you have entered the name Press '<b>OK</b>'</li> </ul>

**NOTE:** Some items will not have saveable configurations, if this is the case the 'Save Config' button will not be selectable.
